



Behaviour, Discipline & Sanctions

Our Aims

This policy exists to:

- Promote good behaviour and a positive team environment
- Ensure every player is able to benefit fully from the tour experience and represent All Star Soccer Academy with pride

Expected Standards

All players are expected to:

- Show mutual consideration, respect and courtesy to fellow players, staff, officials and players from other nations
- Take personal responsibility for their own conduct, learning and development
- Follow the instructions given by coaching and management staff at all times
- Respect the property of others and the facilities provided
- Support the safe and effective running of the tour

Rewarding Good Behaviour

We believe in recognising and celebrating positive behaviour. This may include:

- Praise and recognition from staff
- Player of the Match award
- Special Coach's Award

Sanctions

Where behaviour falls below expected standards, staff may apply sanctions in line with good practice. These may include:

- Requiring a player to apologise to team-mates, opponents, a referee or a coach
- Being dropped or substituted from a match
- Removal from a training session
- Withdrawal of a privilege

For more serious breaches of discipline, the following may also be applied following consultation with the Tour Manager:

- A phone call or written communication to parents/guardians



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- A player being required to return home at the family's expense

Use of Reasonable Force

Any use of physical intervention by staff will be by reasonable and non-injurious means only, used when immediately necessary and for the minimum time required to prevent injury to a person or serious damage to property. Any use of force is recorded in writing. For further information, please refer to the All Star Soccer Academy Use of Reasonable Force Policy.

Records

Any major sanctions administered during the tour are recorded, noting the player's name, the reason for the sanction, and the name of the staff member involved. Records are held by the Tour Manager.
